Mississippi medical students met their match last week.

On Match Day, fourth-year students at The University of Mississippi School of Medicine and William Carey College University College of Medicine learned the location and the specialty of the US residency programs where they will call home for the next 3 to 7 years.

Match Day occurs on the third Friday of March each year at each of the 155 medical schools in the United States where the results of the National Resident Matching Program are announced.
